To: The Right Honorable David Johnston, Independent Special Rapporteur of Canadian Government Re: Foreign Interference in Canada

Dear The Right Honorable David Johnston,

We are writing to you as a group of concerned Canadian citizens with connections to Asia, who are deeply committed to upholding human rights and promoting racial harmony in Canada. Our Association was founded in 1997 to learn and preserve the history of violations of human rights during World War II in Asia. Throughout the years, we have learned that the integrity of democratic institutions is the core protection against militarism and violations of human rights. History tells us that ambitious and expansionist powers have attempted to use all means to interfere with their targeted countries for their benefit, even long before they created a puppet state or conquered a country or region. Canadians paid a high cost to protect freedom in Asia by defending Hong Kong in 1941. Therefore, we, as Canadians, should learn from history, and take heed of foreign interference in varied modern forms and prevent its exploitation of Canada's core values and way of life.

Based on our observations, we believe that foreign interference in Canada is a real and significant threat to our country's national security. The infiltration of the Chinese Communist Party (CCP) on a global and local level is a prime example of this. It is imperative that we acknowledge the severity of this threat and take necessary measures to safeguard our country. Therefore, we suggest the following for your deliberation:

- Conduct a comprehensive and timely public inquiry that exposes the full extent of the Chinese government's interference in Canada. This will help fortify Canadians' trust in the integrity of our democratic institutions and ensure that our democracy remains strong, transparent, and free from external influence.
- Create a Canadian Foreign Influence Transparency Registry. This registry will increase transparency and accountability in our democratic processes, preventing the CCP from manipulating and undermining our institutions.

Thank you for considering our concerns and suggestions. We believe that by taking proactive steps to address these issues, Canada can continue to be a beacon of hope and a model of democratic excellence.


Support publication of The Linguist's Family


